Facts about COVID antibodies testing

- Screening test for antibodies
- Indicates immunity against Covid infection
- Positive result indicates Covid infection in recent past
- Negative result indicates non exposure to Covid 19
- It is not meant for diagnosis of active Covid infection
- Serial testing is required for assessing rising antibodies titre
- It is a regular blood test
- Test results are available on the same day

Who should undergo antibodies testing

- Residents in confinement zones
- › House help, Drivers, Security staff
- Employees wanting to resume work
- Healthcare workers
- Banks/Shops/Office staff
- Airlines staff/Courier people/Cooks
- People who have been infected with Covid 19
- History of Covid 19 symptoms
- Asymptomatic but h/o contact with COVID tested positive person
- Immunosuppressed patients on dialysis, chemotherapy



Wait at least 14 days after symptoms onset to obtain an antibody test

A positive antibody test means that you have developed immune response to the Covid 19 virus. One also, however, needs to rule out active shedding phase by RT PCR TEST if recommended.

- Serial antibody testing over a period of time is useful to see rising antibodies
- It is also useful once vaccine is developed
- Antibodies test is also helpful for eligibility for plasma donors
